# **How to Register:**



- 4-H Camp Registration: 4-H Summer Camp registration is on a first come, first serve basis. Your child(ren) MUST enroll/re-enroll as of January 2021 to be considered registered in 4-H online at <a href="https://v2.4honline.com/">https://v2.4honline.com/</a>. Once you have enrolled each child in 4-H online, your child will be able to participate in the 4-H summer day camps. It is your responsibility for making sure the registration form is correct. Fees are paid in person at the 4-H office BY CASH/CHECK. No Mail in Registrations will be accepted. Camp fees are NON-REFUNDABLE. There is NO waiting list. Registration begins May 10, 2021
- Age Requirement: Age is determined by age on January 1, 2021. Please remember to only sign your
  child up for camps where they meet the age requirement. If your child attends a camp and does not
  meet the age requirement, you will be called to come pick up your child.
- <u>Location</u>: All 4-H Summer Day Camps will be held at the Maxwell Regional Agricultural Convention Center building located at 3114-B Wayne Memorial Drive. We are in Suite B, the N.C. Cooperative Extension office.
- <u>Drop Off/Pick Up:</u> You may drop off your child 10 minutes before each camp. All campers must be picked up at the designated end time for the camp.

#### **COVID-19 PROCEDURES AND GUIDELINES:**

- Participants and staff are required to wear a mask for the entire camp, and participants will be seated six feet apart.
- We will allow time for handwashing/sanitizing during the camp.
- 4-H Staff will be following CDC guidelines for cleaning and disinfecting
